# LEARNING ACTIVITIES AND METHODOLOGY

- General: The general modality of the Bachelor Thesis on Sociology is based on the idea that students work on the subject they prefere, always directed and supervised by their tutors. The general modality includes:
- 4 hours of tutorial in the classroom

- Specific: modality in which a single student works under the direction of a teacher who must previously accept this rol. The student will receive at least 8 hourss of orientation.
