OBJECTIVES

I. Specific competences:

- Domain of the basic legal terminology and understanding of the historical genesis of most of the juridical concepts, so much of the environment of the Public Law as of the Private Law: Roman Law as the European jurists' basic language.

ASSESSMENT SYSTEM
