ASSESSMENT SYSTEM

Continuous assesment is based on ocho practical exercises, as specified in the course programme, of different difficulty and length. The total semester assessment adds up to five points. In addition, attendance and active participation in class receives one point.

It is compulsory to do at least six of eight assessed exercises to follow continuous assessment. The final exam has to be taken to pass.

Students can choose to be assessed only through the final which will be marked with 100% of the final result. Students who do not pass continuous assessment may also be marked in the final exam with 100%.
