OBJECTIVES

- Knowledge of the theoretical framework, the operational principles, and the potential use and applications of the most relevant qualitative analysis methods within the field of the social sciences, and especially in the area of sociology.
- Ability to analyze multiple kinds of qualitative data (transcriptions, audiovisual resources, digital communication) using the methodologies explained in class.
- Computer-related skills for the use of qualitative data analysis software.

LEARNING ACTIVITIES AND METHODOLOGY

The course will include both lectures and practical sessions. The professor will use online lectures to present the main contents of the course. In the practical sessions, learning-by-doing exercises will allow students get familiar with the reading, manipulation and analysis of qualitative data. The practical exercises to be administered in class will cover a variety of scenarios: both individual work and teamwork; the making of written and oral assignments, or the combination of both; the use of qualitative analysis software. Students will have the opportunity to solve any doubts and questions that might arise during the course in the context of individual tutoring sessions. In addition, the arrangement of collective tutoring sessions will enable the monitoring of teamwork.

ASSESSMENT SYSTEM

Continuous assessment will be based in the submission of nine assignments of varying levels of difficulty and workload which represent, in total, up to four points. Teamwork will receive at maximum two points. In addition, class participation will count up to one point. To complete the continuous assessment regime, at least six out of the nine assignments need to be submitted. Regardless of its academic results, the completion of this regime will not exonerate students from the duty of taking the final exam. Students who did not successfully pass the continuous assessment, as well as those who skipped it from the beginning of the semester, can choose to be assessed only through the final, which in both cases will be marked with 100% of the final result.
