Carry out the analysis of works of art and architecture to be able to develop cultural, tourist and leisure tasks in them Assess the role of art in the tourist offer

Regarding general abilities or skills, the student will be able to:

- The ability to search, communicate and discriminate what is the relevant information for a given decision.
- The ability to apply multidisciplinary knowledge to the resolution of a given problem.
- The analytical capacity to recognize different aspects and elements and to be able to solve diverse problems.

Ensure the protection and conservation of works of art and historic buildings.
