LEARNING ACTIVITIES AND METHODOLOGY

The continuous evaluation system is based on a practice-oriented teaching that aims to reinforce the learning of theory through direct experience in cases that should facilitate the understanding and handling of its content.

The academic activities are divided into Lectures (large group) and Practice Sessions (small groups).

1. Master Lessons (Large Groups), in which the general outlines of the subject matter of the corresponding topic will be presented.

2. Practical Sessions (Small Groups), in which specific activities will be developed in order to offer a practical vision of the content of the topics. The activities to be developed will consist of the resolution of practical exercises, as well as, if necessary, other control activities such as the reading of bibliography or relevant sentences and test or surprise questions to check the level of knowledge on the topics. These activities will be duly announced in Aula Global.

Tutorials will be held at the time and under the conditions determined by the professor in Aula Global.

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ASSESSMENT SYSTEM

The overall evaluation of the course in the ordinary call will be based on the weighting of the grades obtained in the continuous evaluation activities, which is equivalent to 40% of the final grade. The grade of the final exam is equivalent to the remaining 60%.

The final grade obtained may be adjusted by the teacher (up to a maximum of one point) according to the participation and interventions in class.

Each professor may require in his group a minimum grade in the final exam to perform the global evaluation, provided that he expressly indicates it at the beginning of the term, through Aula Global or any other means. In that case, the final grade will be the one that corresponds to apply according to the agreement of the Board of Faculty of Social and Legal Sciences of December 16, 2014, available at link https://e-archivo.uc3m.es/handle/10016/21141.

The evaluation in the extraordinary call, if the student followed continuous assessment will be entitled to have the grade of the same taken into account (provided that it benefits him/her), and if he/she did not follow it will be entitled to take a final exam worth 100% of the total grade of the subject.

Students who do not take the final exam, either in the ordinary or extraordinary call, will be considered as not presented.

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
