- Unit 5. The sound heritage: sources, collections and management
- Unit 6. Digitalization projects of the audiovisual heritage

LEARNING ACTIVITIES AND METHODOLOGY

1. Lectures

Basic knowledge of the audiovisual heritage, the problems of preservation of the supports, and the processes of digitalization. Competencies 1, 2 and 3 (1 ECTS).

2. Practical work

Practical classes with resources with audiovisual heritage. Competencies 3 and 4. (1 ECTS).

3. Student work

Supervised study of theoretical and practical content, teaching materials and processing jobs. Competencies 1, 2 and 3 (1 ECTS).
