The practical teachings are looking for two specific objectives: training and coaching students in what they are learning and to the implementation of the readings that will need to make during the course.

Objectives:

- 2.- strengthen the necessary skills for a journalist who has to develop his work in Parliament.
- 3.- guide the analysis of each event and the importance of the debate as a tool of learning, critical and providing solutions for the future and move him from the idea of debate sterile confrontation.

ASSESSMENT SYSTEM

50 of the final grade will be conditioned by the participation in practical classes and assistance to them. For this will be:

- 1. by groups they will have to keep track of commissions of the Congress of Deputies. Each one of them.
- 2. by groups they will have to do two times, throughout the semester, an exposition of the theoretical contents have been explained in the theoretical classes. Teacher will ask individual questions to members of the group.
- 3. individually will have to participate, once maximum, as speakers of a topical subject, that serve as a debate. All others must provide written in five lines, its attitude towards this issue.

At the end of the debate will be completed with other ten lines written explaining, in Chronicles, the development debate and personal contributions that he has drawn from it.

- 4. individually will be an oral presentation of five minutes on any of the topics explained in class
- 5. individually delivered a course on a topic of current work: development and analysis.

The remaining 50 will be the qualification resulting from the theory test.
