**ASSESSMENT SYSTEM****ORDINARY EXAM:**

The mark obtained by the student shall take into account: a continuous evaluation, with a value of 50% of the final mark, and an exam at the end of the sessions, which shall entail the 50% left.

The mentioned continuous evaluation shall be made taking into account the work of the student during the course, among other things, through the comment of literary and legal texts, watching and commenting films, and the making of written papers and oral statements, whether individually or in groups.

The final exam (50% of the mark) shall consist of questions made to grade the student's understanding of the theory lessons, as well as his capacity to proceed to the application in practice of the knowledge acquired.

\* To pass the exam it shall be necessary to obtain a minimum of 2.5 points.

**EXTRAORDINARY EXAM:**

The exam of the extraordinary call will consist of two parts: a first theoretical-practical test evaluable for five points (50%); a second consisting of a practical case evaluable for another 5 (50%).

Those who have not followed the continuous assessment must necessarily take both parts (theoretical and practical), and must pass both (2.5 points for the theoretical part; 2.5 points for the practical part) in order to obtain the final grade of pass.

Those who despite having followed the continuous assessment wish to take the practical part of the exam because they consider this option, as stated in the regulation (Agreement of the UCIIM Governing Council 31 May 2011) "more favourable", it is understood that they renounce the grade obtained in the continuous assessment throughout the term.
