1. HERRAMIENTAS Y PLATAFORMAS UTILIZADAS PARA EL DESARROLLO DE LAS ACTIVIDADES DOCENTES

- 1. TOOLS AND PLATFORMS USED FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE ACTIVITIES
- Lectures have taken place as synchronous sessions on Blackboard Collaborate. These sessions were also recorded and made available for students to view them afterwards if needed. The materials to follow these sessions were uploaded to Aula Global.
- Reduced sessions have been transformed into working sessions where students are asked to work individually in
 activities while I remain connected for consultation. These activities include questionnaires on Google Sheets or
 submitting short activities where they show that they have understood and can use the concepts and arguments
 taught during the lectures.
- Office hours have also been transformed into online availability adapted to the needs of students: e-mail, Skype meetings, etc.

 - 2. ADAPTATION OF TEACHING ACTIVITIES AND TIME SCHEDULE

Despite the initial, two-week suspension, in the end, only one week of classes was missed in early March (11-18th). Luckily the contents of this session were transversal to the course, and they were broken down and integrated in the following sessions. No significant reduction of the contents occurred.

Students were informed through Aula Global of the changes mentioned in section 1 in the schedule and course syllabus.

- 3. ASSESSMENT SYSTEM
- Evaluation was redefined in order to award continuous evaluation a 100 percent of the final grade. To do so, it was agreed with the students that they would do weekly activities that before the sanitary emergency were done in class and marked generally as participation. Instead of a final exam, to test students understanding of the course they were asked to hand in a long essay.
- These changes were agreed with students and duly communicated through a message sent through Aula Global.
- For those students who chose to dispense, the possibility to do one exam in the extraordinary period is still
 made available.
