The ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) credit represents the amount of work done by the student to meet program objectives .

1 ECTS = 25 hours of student learning credit, which correspond to seven hours teaching and the remaining 18 to personal study outside the classroom.

This means that the 6 ECTS a subject involving a total of 150 hours of total student work, of which 42 hours are devoted classes, plus 6 hours of recovery and examination. Half hours of total loans and student work in the subjects of 3 ECTS credits

The student completes the value of credits (6 credits = 150 hours) with 102 hours spent on personal work outside the classroom. This work includes, among other possible activities , practical work , exercises , homework, study and preparation of the course and examination .
