

SUBJECT**WOMEN'S PROTECTION IN CRIMINAL AND PROCEDURAL
LAW**

The subject of Criminal and Procedural Protection of Women belongs to the Specialization Module (optional) of the Master in Criminal Law and Criminal Procedural Law, with a theoretical and practical approach to the criminal and procedural tools that we have at national and comparative level for the adequate protection of women.

It is necessary to approach the magnitude of the phenomenon, as an objective reality, studying the whole social framework that maintains this violence, as well as the measures adopted from different spheres to eradicate it. Special attention should be paid to the European and Latin American criminal policy implemented to respond to these behaviors and the results obtained in this regard, the effect of the penalties and the possible ways to solve the phenomenon, emphasizing the need for the imposition of precautionary measures during the course of the process and that the penalties, if convicted, should not be limited to traditional custodial sentences, but to the accessory ones depriving of rights.

During 12 sessions of this course, the basic concepts for a proper approach to this problem, the most relevant international legal instruments are addressed, and we will end with the legal-criminal treatment in Spain delving into various forms and manifestations of gender violence and the necessary awareness measures.
