**CYBERCRIME**

The subject 'Cybercrime' belongs to the Specialization Module (optional) of the Master's Degree in Criminal Law and Criminal Procedure, with a theoretical and practical approach to the digital phenomenon and, specifically, criminal offenses committed through new technologies.

The appearance of this subject is justified by the increase of criminality committed through the Internet, affecting legal assets ranging from patrimony and socioeconomic order, sexual indemnity of minors and incapable persons, privacy, intellectual and industrial property, etc.

During 12 sessions of this course, the phenomena affecting online crime, the impact of the complexity of new forms of technology and data protection, and the need to generate effective responses, such as confiscation, criminal liability of legal persons, and the regulation of bank secrecy to discourage the commission of these crimes are addressed.
