The subject of Criminalistics belongs to the Specialisation Module (optional) of the Master's Degree in Criminal Law and Criminal Procedure, with a theoretical-practical focus on the techniques of criminalistics used for police and judicial investigation.

At any crime scene we can find a series of data, traces and evidence whose meticulous and precise analysis can lead to the discovery of the circumstances surrounding the commission of crimes, as well as the identification of the alleged perpetrator. The immediate and exhaustive work of all the experts is essential in order to achieve the expected goal, without forgetting that any action must be carried out with strict respect for the system of guarantees and fundamental rights.

During the 2 weeks of this subject, the main characteristics of criminalistics are covered, as well as the cornerstone of any investigation: Technical Ocular Inspection, lophoscopy; forensic photography; the practical actions of the FCSE; forensic traumatology; graphistics and forensic entomology. All of this is approached from the most practical perspective with the presentation and analysis of practical cases.
